Our goal is to rehabilitate and empower victims of terror, wounded soldiers, and bereaved families, so they can achieve their emotional and financial independence, and successfully reintegrate into society.

We are **ONE** unique **FAMILY** of professionals, volunteers, donors, and the **VICTIMS** and **SURVIVORS** of terror attacks in Israel since 2000—bereaved, maimed, and traumatized—who suffer from physical pain and trauma.

WHEN TERROR STRIKES—WE ACT

IMMEDIATE RESPONSE: Following a terror attack, **OneFamily** rushes to meet the urgent physical and emotional needs of the victims and their families.

CONTINUED SUPPORT: We provide a comprehensive blend of therapeutic programs, and financial, legal, and medical assistance, tailor-made for each family member, and delivered in our hallmark "family" atmosphere of trust and togetherness.

ONGOING REHABILITATION FOR PTSD: We offer an array of therapeutic programs designed for orphans, bereaved parents and siblings, widows and widowers, and the wounded themselves.

ADVOCACY: OneFamily advocates for and assists victims in accessing entitlements from government and official sources.


We remain devoted to all victims of terror in Israel.



OneFamily sponsors many therapeutic workshops and emotional support groups for parents mourning a child, including: Bereaved Mothers' Cooking Classes, Bereaved Fathers' Choir, Wounded Couples Group, and Couples Therapy and Support.

We found that a change of scenery and a change of pace—with other parents who understand their pain—can be extremely therapeutic.

To help, we organize special healing retreats for parents, and provide personalized encouragement from staff and trained volunteers, legal advice, and financial support when needed.



OneFamily visited every soldier and civilian wounded during Operation Protective Edge, bringing comfort and cheer.

During **Operation Protective Edge**, **OneFamily** staff and volunteers attended funerals and visited each *shiva* house. We looked after surviving children and filled refrigerators for victims too distraught to leave their homes.

We sent hundreds of families from southern Israel to retreats in the north for a few days of respite from the relentless missile attacks.

Our volunteers assembled and delivered care packages, helped fix and rebuild homes that were hit by missiles, and ran household errands for victims who were too overwhelmed to perform simple tasks.

We visited every wounded soldier and civilian in the hospital . . . more than 463 . . . and continue to visit those who remain hospitalized.

OneFamily does whatever we can to comfort the wounded and the bereaved.

In 2011, Palestinian terrorists entered the home of Ruth and Udi Fogel, murdering them and three of their six children.

Ruth's parents, Tali and Yehuda BenYishai, adopted their surviving grandchildren, and during these darkest moments, **OneFamily** entered their lives. We would not let them face their ordeal alone.

We helped and continue to help the family cope with their grief. Our counselors developed warm relationships with the children, who are also attending **OneFamily** camps. And Tali joined our Bereaved Mothers Support Group. "We cannot thank **OneFamily** enough for their ongoing love, help, and support." said Tali.

The Fogel/BenYishai families are two of thousands OneFamily is helping, extending our support for as long as they need it.

When it Comes to Family, We Do Whatever it Takes!

FOUNDED IN 2001, One-Family's integrated network of volunteers, field and social workers, staff, and therapists, has helped thousands of Israeli terror victims along their arduous journeys from a life filled with extreme loss and pain, to one filled with greater hope for the future.

In a given year, OneFamily provides (partial listing): Financial Assistance:

- 3,200 families receive direct financial aid
- 529 families receive food vouchers for Passover
- 91 wounded IDF soldiers receive vouchers of \$190
- 12 university scholarships awarded

HEALING RETREATS, SUPPORT GROUPS, AND WORKSHOPS:

- 535 war widows, terror victims, and orphans participate in various healing retreats across Israel
- 329 people participate in therapeutic retreats and support groups
- **150** bereaved and wounded singles, ages 22-32, travel overseas for *healing* retreats
- 2,550 families receive Purim packages

YOUTH DIVISION (for children ages 8-18 who have lost parents or siblings, or who are themselves, survivors):

- 769 children attend our Hanukkah, Passover, and Summer camps
- 285 children in southern Israel receive new school backpacks and gift cards to purchase school supplies
